



7. Roger Simons had suggested, to the NAG1 meeting that all exit routes from the rave bar one should be blocked and Police could then check vehicles and drivers leaving the site and arrest anyone breaking the law without using too many officers.
8. Speaking of NAG1 generally, Roger Simons said the Chair was now much more positive and things were getting done. The Chair had reported attending a subsequent meeting where the Chief Constable was very positive about the future police action in the event of a rave. Any reports to the Police at Kidlington should refer to raves and perceived drugs related problems and not noise which must be reported separately to Vale of White Horse Environment Protection Department.
