**List of Assets Ashbury Parish Council (APC): owned by and with responsibility for maintenance or with maintenance responsibilities only as of April 2023**

**During 22022- 2023 financial year Ashbury Parish Council (APC) funded:**

1. the restoration build work required for the Ashbury Parish owned Bus Shelter on High Street Ashbury. This bus shelter was first build in 1955, with funds provided by William Cash on the understanding that the bus shelter would receive ongoing maintenance by APC



2. the pruning of the lower branches of the 6 lime trees in Church Lane and removal of the extensive ivy growing up each of the lime tree trunks. These Lime Trees were funded by William Cash in 1953 at the same time as the 2 benches in Church Lane to mark the coronation of Queen Elizabeth 11.



3. the pruning of the lower branches, removal of some dead branches and removal of self seeded trees on the left side of Walnut Trees Hill as you drive towards Wantage on the B4507 (4 trees)
